## Tangipahoa African American Heritage Museum

### FROM BATON ROUGE, LA

- Merge I-12 East
- Take the US-51 Business exit – EXIT 40
- Turn LEFT onto US-51 BR/SW Railroad Ave.
- Turn LEFT onto Phoenix Square/Capitol One Bank

### FROM COVINGTON, LA

- Merge I-12 West
- Take the US-51 Business exit – EXIT 40
- Turn RIGHT onto US-51/SW Railroad Ave.
- Turn LEFT onto Phoenix Square/Capitol One Bank

### FROM JACKSON, MS

- I-55 South
- Take the Hwy 190 Business exit – EXIT 31
- Turn right onto Mooney Ave.
- Turn left onto Phoenix Square

### FROM NEW ORLEANS, LA

- I-55 North
- Take the Hwy 190 Business exit – EXIT 31
- Turn RIGHT on Hwy 190/W. Thomas St.
- Turn RIGHT on Mooney Ave.
- Turn LEFT on Phoenix Square
